#### The Venue

University "G. d'Annunzio" of Chieti-Pescara Viale Pindaro 42, 65127 Pescara (PE)

Pescara is an Italian city located in the Abruzzo region, on the Adriatic coast. It is known for its beaches and for being the birthplace of the poet Gabriele D'Annunzio. On the other hand, Chieti is among the most ancient of Italian cities. According to a legend, the city was founded by Achille and was named *Thetis* after his mother.

The territory offers a mix of nature, suggestive landscapes and a variety of outdoor activities. The beaches of Abruzzo vary from sandy in the North to pebble in the South. Also, the small villages of the hinterland, as well as the monasteries and castles of the region, are very charming and are part of many touristic routes in the "greenest region" of Italy.


